

Closet Care & Cleaning

General Care

- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, which can cause fading or discoloration of materials and finishes.
- Avoid excessive heat or moisture near closet panels, drawers, or shelves.
- Always handle drawers gently to prevent misalignment or hardware damage

Cleaning Instructions

- **Routine Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Immediately follow with a dry, clean cloth to remove any excess moisture.
- **Mild Cleaning Solution:** If needed, use a mild dish soap diluted with warm water. Test on a small, inconspicuous area first.
- **Do Not Use:** Harsh detergents, bleach, ammonia, abrasive pads, or solvent-based cleaners, as these can damage the surface finish.
- **Hardware:** Clean hardware with a soft cloth. Avoid spraying cleaners directly on hardware.
- Use a clean microfiber cloth for dusting.
- For fingerprints or smudges, use a mild non-abrasive cleaner formulated for laminates.
- Avoid high-pressure water, steam cleaners, or wax-based polishes.

Drawers, Shelves, and Connectors

- Periodically check that any visible mounting screws are secure. Do not overload shelves or drawers beyond the recommended weight capacity.
- Do not overload shelves beyond the recommended weight capacity.
- For smooth drawer operation, ensure glides are free of dust and debris.
